Sotirios Boukis is the Youth Pastor of the Greek Evangelical Church of Thessaloniki and the delegate of the Greek Evangelical Church in the Faith and Order Commission of the World Council of Churches.

He is currently a Ph.D. candidate in the School of Theology of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, focusing on the use of the Patristic Tradition among the first Greek Evangelicals and its significance for the contemporary ecumenical speculation. In the past he has studied Theology at Fuller Theological Seminary in U.S.A. (M.Div.), in the School of Theology of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (M.Th.) and in the Greek Bible College (B.Th.), while he also holds a B.S. in Communication, Media and Civilization from Panteion University. He has been involved for more than a decade in ecumenical meetings and activities of various organizations, including the Southern California Ecumenical Council, the National Council of Churches (U.S.A.), the WCC Commission for World Mission and Evangelism, and the Greek National Evangelical Alliance.
